Camping Questions & Answers

- **What should I bring?** You will need a tent, sleeping bag or blankets, insect repellents, extra shoes, clothing, toiletries, raincoat, flashlight, eating utensils, food with cooler, cooking utensils, & your SCOUT SPIRIT!
- **Where will we camp?** Families will be grouped by pack into campsites. Each campsite has a fire ring. Campfires **MUST** remain in the provided fire rings.
- **Will summer camp tents be up?** No.
- **When can I check-in?** You may check in Friday night from 4pm-8pm or Saturday from 8am until 11am.
- **How do I get my gear to the campsite?** At registration, there will be a limited number of vehicles that may enter the camp. Each vehicle allowed to enter **MUST** drop off gear and return to parking **BEFORE** setting up their camp. Vehicles will **NOT** be allowed into camp Saturday during camp activities.
- **Are there restrooms at the campsites?** Latrines are located near all sites. Please bring your own toilet paper. Bathroom and shower buildings are available in walking distance from each campsite.
- **Will meals be provided?** No. Fire pits are available at each campsite and you may bring camp stoves. Packs are encouraged to cook meals as a group.
- **Can I fish at the lake?** Fishing is allowed from the shoreline. Crappie, catfish, bass, and lake trout are commonly caught in the lake. **All fishing is catch and release.**

BSA and the Northeast Georgia Council Campground Policies prohibit the following:

- No alcoholic beverages or illicit drugs allowed.
- No smoking in campsites, please use only designated areas.
- No pets are allowed.
- Build campfires in established fire rings only. Please do not build fires on the field. Do not leave fires unattended and put fires out cold before bed. You must have a fire bucket with water and a shovel available at each fire ring.
- No fire arms or fireworks in campground.
- All liquid fuels must be handled by adults. Do not use liquid fuels on the camp fire.
- Promptly remove all vehicles from the campground, no unauthorized vehicles will be allowed in the campground after designated times. Failure to move a vehicle may result in its being towed at owners expense.

Directions to Camp Rainey Mountain

- Take I-985 N to US 441 N into Clayton, GA
 - Turn right in Clayton at the stop light onto US 76E (you will see a McDonalds on the left).
 - Go 4.2 miles and turn left onto Rainey Mountain Road.
 - Follow the road in to camp.
 - Park in the parking lot on the right and walk to camp office for check in.
- PLEASE NOTE:** Using a GPS is not advised as the accuracy is known to decrease in the area.
